

Fannin County Bicycle Route Map

Route Ratings

Green = Least Difficult Bicycling. Generally has at least three of the following conditions – low traffic volumes, slower speed traffic, lane widths adequate to provide cyclist maneuvering room, terrain is moderately flat.

Orange = Moderate Difficulty Bicycling. Generally has at least three of the following conditions – traffic volumes are moderate, moderate speed traffic, lane widths adequate to provide cyclist maneuvering room, terrain is moderately rolling.

Red = Most Difficulty Bicycling. Generally has at least one of the following conditions – heavy traffic volumes, high traffic speed, lane widths less than desired for cyclist maneuvering, steeper terrain.

Route Descriptions

- Route 1 – TriCities Loop** – follows Ga. Hwys 5, 515, and 60 connecting the Cities of Blue Ridge, McCaysville, and Morganton.
- Route 1a** – starts on Route 1 between Blue Ridge and McCaysville and follows Tom Boyd Road to Fannin County Park.
- Route 1b** – starts at Route 1 in McCaysville and follows River Road to Horseshoe Bend Park.
- Route 1c** – begins on Route 2 just outside Blue Ridge and follows Old Hwy 76 to Ga. Hwy 60. It travels over Lake Blue Ridge Dam.
- Route 2 – Blue Ridge Bikeway** - connects the City of Blue Ridge with Gilmer County to the south following Scenic Drive and Sugar Creek Road. From Blue Ridge east it follows Old Hwy 76, Aska Road, and Ga. Hwy 60 to Union County. This route travels through historic Dial Valley.
